

October 6, 2009

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Dale Shelley and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Planning Director David Bardell, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, Times Reporter Paulette Forry and Lewistown Sentinel Reporter Micaiah Bilger .

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Minutes of the September 29 meeting were approved as submitted.

Bardell gave a brief update on the recycling program. Presently, he is searching for alternative recycling options. He is also contacting vendors in the hopes of having "drop offs" available at various locations throughout the County. He is asking the community to continue their participation in the recycling program. Recently residents have called and are looking for alternatives to the present sites. Bardell suggested Kramer's Recycling in McAlisterville, Mifflin County Solid Waste or Pheasant Valley Recycling as options.

The commissioners took the following actions:

- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a Subrecipient Agreement with Mifflin-Juniata Dental Clinic outlining requirements for FFY 2009 CDBG funds in the amount of \$12,500.00.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a Subrecipient Agreement with the Mifflintown Municipal Authority outlining requirements for FFY 2009 CDBG funds in the amount of \$28,948.00.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved placing an ad in the Association of Township Supervisors annual convention program at a cost of \$50.00.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, appointed Rick Stuter to the CSBG Board.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a request from the Records Improvement Fund Committee to fund the purchase of a copier including a 3-year service contract, for the Prison, at a cost of \$5,280.00.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved tax exonerations for Lack Township.

Commissioner Zimmerman stated an RFP is in the process of being finalized for the replacement of Courthouse windows.

Commissioner Zimmerman noted the Tax Collection Committee will meet on October 27 at 7:00 p.m. in the Fermanagh Elementary School All Purpose Room.

#### Retirement Board

No business was brought before the Board.

On motion of O'Neal/Shelley, and unanimously carried, the Board recessed at 10:10 a.m. and adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
