

December 8, 2009

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Dale Shelley and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, Times Reporter Paulette Forry and Lewistown Sentinel Reporter Micaiah Bilger .

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Minutes of the December 1 meeting were approved as submitted.

The commissioners took the following actions:

- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved an Application for County Aid submitted by Port Royal Borough for 2 storm sewer boxes and 100' pipe, cold patch and anti skid in the amount of \$2,676.98.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved the 2010 Commissioners' Board meetings, Salary Board and Retirement Board meetings.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved the 2010 Commissioners' Board meetings.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, re-appointed Nancy Lebkicher and Geraldine Mills to three-year terms on the Advisory Committee of the Children and Youth Social Services Agency.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, re-appointed Mark R. Partner to serve a five-year term on the Industrial Development Authority. Mark's term will commence January 1, 2010 and expire December 31, 2014.

O'Neal gave a brief update on the upcoming census. She met with the Census Bureau representatives who will be overseeing Juniata County and indicated there is a push to hire door to door census takers. A website is available for those wishing to apply. In mid March the census surveys will be released. For those who do not return the surveys, a census representative will be making door to door visits. O'Neal stressed the importance of everyone being counted. Those who are vacationing outside Juniata County should complete the survey that is sent to their home address. If a survey is received where that individual is vacationing, they should clearly indicate on the survey that the address where the survey was received is a vacation home.
