The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Dale Shelley and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were members of the public Clarissa and Steve Ehrenzeller, Jenna and Susan Hackenberger, Chief Assessor Jeff Haines, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn and Lewistown Sentinel Reporter Micaiah Bilger .

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Minutes of the June 1st meeting were approved as submitted.

The Commissioners acknowledged the 2010 Nestler Scholarship recipients. The East Juniata High School recipient is Clarissa Ehrenzeller who attended the meeting with her father Steve and the Juniata High School recipient is Jenna Hackenberger who attended with her mother Susan. Clarissa will be attending Messiah College in the fall with an undeclared major. Jenna will be attending Washington & Jefferson as a Biology major in the pre-optometry program.

The commissioners took the following actions:

- The INFOCON proposal presented at last week's meeting failed to pass for lack of a second after motion by O'Neal to approve.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved an Emergency Response Service Agreement submitted by Allen Weaver, Emergency Services Coordinator.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved Act 148 invoices for July 1, 2009 – March 31, 2010, submitted by Children & Youth Director Helen Henry.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a Purchase of Service Agreement with Adelphoi Village, Inc., submitted by Children & Youth Director Helen Henry.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a Grant Agreement for the State Food Purchase Program for FY 2010-2011.
- On motion of Zimmerman/Shelley approved checks #29,826 through #29,860 in the amount of \$153,732.20. O'Neal voted against the motion because of ongoing concerns with line items.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved Greenway, Open Space and Rural Recreation Plan check #133, payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in the amount of \$105.70.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved tax exonerations for Susquehanna and Walker Townships.

- No action was taken.

#### Retirement Board

- No action was taken.

On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Board recessed at 10:25 a.m. and adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
