

June 9, 2009

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Dale Shelley and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were representing the Seeing Eye Dog Program Jim, Jean, Jensen and Marley Swartz with Alpha and Bangle; John, Hunter, Aleighcia and Riley Hepner with Taffy; Caitlin Queitzsch with Gilbert; Melissa, Althea and Ashley Swartz with Bandit; Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, Times Reporter Paulette Forry and Lewistown Sentinel Reporter Micaiah Bilger.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On motion of O'Neal/Zimmerman, approved as submitted, the Minutes of June 2nd.

The Commissioners took the following actions:

- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved Proclamation No. 2009-4 proclaiming the week of June 22-29, a week celebrating the Seeing Eye's 80th anniversary.
- Acknowledged receipt and approval of the May check register covering checks #22,915 through #23,104, totaling \$600,003.85.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved an Application for County Aid submitted by Milford Township in the amount of \$1,561.18 for paving T-383, T-410, T-411, T-340 and T-341.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved tax exonerations for Susquehanna Township.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved Comprehensive Plan check #140, payable to Juniata County Commissioners in the amount of \$10,841.68.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, adopted Resolution No. 2009-3 urging the General Assembly to adopt a responsible budget that maintains funding for core government services and does not shift costs to the local level.
- Made note of information that is now available online for eligible recipients to check the status of property tax and rent rebate applications. The information can be found at www.papropertytaxrelief.com.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved CDBG check #193, payable to SEDA-COG in the amount of \$164.67.
