The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Dale Shelley and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Helen Henry and Penni Abram, Children and Youth, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, Times Reporter Paulette Forry and Lewistown Sentinel Reporter Micaiah Bilger.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by The Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Minutes of the November 3, 2009 meeting were approved as presented.

Commissioner Zimmerman took a moment to recognize Veterans Day stating, "America remains the best hope for those who do not live in freedom. Our nation's cause is liberty, justice and peace, and millions across the world breathe free today because of American soldiers who fought and sacrificed for that cause. The commissioners took the following actions:

- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a proposal from Eastern Elevation Service to repair the lift located in the Bousum Building. Cost is \$4015 plus labor.
