

June 15, 2010

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Dale Shelley and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were members of the public Ernie Sweitzer, Times Reporter Paulette Forry, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, and Lewistown Sentinel Reporters Micaiah Bilger and David Smooke .

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Minutes of the June 8th meeting were approved as submitted.

Sweitzer was again present to clarify his Right To Know request and to request additional information. In order to clarify his previous request, Sweitzer stated he was not asking what the County had paid to King Financial but the amount of money King Financial has received since the County invested \$1.8 million in 2000. Additionally, he requested a copy of the check indicating to whom the payment was made and monthly statements from 2000 to the present, directly from the investment house, indicating commissions and any other expenses paid from that account. Commissioner Zimmerman indicated the County will honor his request. Commissioner O'Neal issued a personal statement saying she was embarrassed that she did not know the answer to his original request which was the amount King Financial has received from the investments. Further she stated "we should know this".

The commissioners took the following actions:

- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved an Application for County Aid submitted by Mifflintown Borough in the amount of \$2,031.96.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved an FFY2010 Emergency Management Performance Grant in the amount of \$54,501.00 for reimbursement of salaries and benefits.
- Acknowledged receipt of the May Monthly Statistical Report submitted by Children & Youth Director Helen Henry and the Probation and Parole report submitted by Chief Probation Officer Michelle Beaver.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved tax exonerations for Thompsontown Borough and Fayette Township, pending signature on one Thompsontown Borough exoneration.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved HazMat check #1064, payable to Sheetz Advantage in the amount of \$185.50.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a Service Agreement with Families First submitted by Children & Youth Director Helen Henry.
- On motion of Shelley/Zimmerman, approved checks #29,863, 29,867, 29,868 and 29,869 through 29,931 totaling \$22,783.51. Commissioner O'Neal voted against the motion because of ongoing issues with late charges and over -budget line items.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a recommendation from the Prison Board to hire Mike Rayson to fill a part-time CO position beginning June 7, 2010.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, accepted the resignation of Ronda Detra as Enforcement Officer in Domestic Relations effective June 17, 2010. The position will not be filled at this time.

Salary Board

- No action was taken.

Retirement Board

- No action was taken.

On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Board recessed at 10:35 a.m. and adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
