

April 23, 2013

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Robert Reynolds and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill and Register & Recorder Alicia Seigler.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by O'Neal and a second by Zimmerman, the Minutes of the April 16, 2013 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- The Commissioners reviewed the March 2013 "Summary of Collections Report – Fines and Costs" as submitted by Jacqueline T. Leister, Magisterial District Judge.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Zimmerman to approve the tax exonerations for Walker Township as per the material provided. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Zimmerman to approve the "Juniata County Security Grant – Year Two" between Juniata County and Mifflin-Juniata Human Services for the period April 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Zimmerman to appoint Penni L. Abram Juniata County Children and Youth Services Director. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Zimmerman and seconded by O'Neal to acknowledge the resignation of Glenn S. Kerstetter as Deputy Register and Recorder of Juniata County effective April 26, 2013. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Zimmerman and seconded by O'Neal to approve the hiring of Karen E. Stouffer as Deputy Register and Recorder of Juniata County effective May 1, 2013. The starting wage for the position, which is classified as part-time, will be set as per the current bargaining unit contract. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Zimmerman and seconded by O'Neal to acknowledge the resignation of Keith A. Altiery as Adult Probation Officer effective April 26, 2013. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Zimmerman to approve checks #37379 - #37430 in the amount of \$163,775.23. The motion was unanimously carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Zimmerman to recess at 10:07 a.m. followed by adjournment at 11:00 a. m. The motion was unanimously carried.
