

April 27, 2010

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Dale Shelley and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were members of the public Clair Bair, Jr., Amanda and Sarah Howard; State Health Office representative Linda Allen; Carol Moyer, Case Manager for the WIA Title 1 Program; Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn; Times Reporter Paulette Forry and Lewistown Sentinel Reporter Micaiah Bilger .

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Minutes of the April 20th meeting were approved as submitted.

Bair requested the status of the Courthouse renovations. Commissioner Zimmerman stated there is a construction meeting to be held following the Commissioners' Board meeting and an update will be provided at next week's meeting.

Moyer who is the Adult Case Manager for the WIA Title 1 Program gave a brief summary of the services that the program provides to Juniata County residents. Moyer is housed at the TIU office two days a week and provides career service help for adults. Presently only testing is provided at the Juniata County site.

- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved the MATP Report for quarter ending March 31, 2010 submitted by Call-A-Ride Service.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved HazMat check #1056, payable to New Pig Corporation in the amount of \$467.50.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved the Quarterly HAVA Grant Reimbursement Request and Performance Report submitted by Eva Stong, Voter Registrar.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved Chris Kelly moving from part-time corrections officer to full time effective April 19, 2010.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, appointed Jeffrey M. Zimmerman to serve the unexpired term of Louis DiGiulio on the Industrial Development Authority Board through December 31, 2013.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, acknowledged the resignation of Ronni L. Kirk as secretary for the Sheriff's Office effective May 17, 2010.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, acknowledged Melissa Pallotto has been hired as Domestic Relations Director effective May 3, 2010.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, acknowledged receiving the 2010-2011 HSDF allocations.

Commissioner O'Neal requested that information such as reports and minutes be shared by all Commissioners for meetings they attend.

On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Board adjourned at 10:25 a.m.
