

April 28, 2009

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Dale Shelley and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Chief Probation Officer Michelle Beaver and School Based Probation Officer Chris Tate, Times Reporter Paulette Forry, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn and Lewistown Sentinel Reporter Micaiah Bilger.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the April 21st minutes were approved as submitted.

Beaver and Tate gave an update on the new school-based probation officer position. Tate spends at least 70% of his time between the two schools – Juniata and East Juniata High Schools. Tracking of the hours and work completed are being done as required by the grant. In 2007 – 2008 there were 6 students placed because of probation violations. For 2008-2009 the number had dropped to 2. Additionally electronic monitoring has been implemented.

Beaver reported 20 county employees attended pepper spray training provided by the Probation Office.

The Commissioners took the following actions:

- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved the HAVA Grant Reimbursement Request and Performance Report – Section 261, Working Capital Request and Performance Report Title I and Title II, Sections 101 and 251, submitted by Eva Stong, Voter Registrar.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, accepted the remainder of the ICOP Agreement for the Court related unit. Receipt of the arbitrated issues was acknowledged at the January 27, 2009 meeting.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved tax exonerations for Tuscarora and Fermanagh Townships.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, adopted the revised Resolution No. 2009-2.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a recommendation from Allen Weaver, Emergency Services Director, to hire Rodney E. Bryner to fill the open telecommunicator position in the 911 Center. Bryner will start as soon as possible at the stated Union salary.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved Housing Rehab check #191, payable to Michale Felmler, in the amount of \$8,800.00.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a Purchase of Service Agreement with YES (Youth Educational Services) Academy submitted by Children and Youth.

Zimmerman stated the Board had met with Manatron and 21st Century to discuss software and hardware as well as updates for the Assessment Office.

No business was brought before the Board.

Retirement Board

No business was brought before the Board.

On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Board recessed at 10:25 a.m. and adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
