Juniata County Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan

WHEREAS, Juniata County, is vulnerable to natural hazards such as flooding, and drought and manmade hazards such as transportation, and can result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and

WHEREAS, the counties of Perry, Juniata and Mifflin jointly applied and received a federal Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) grant to develop and submit for approval their respective multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plans, and

WHEREAS, the County Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Juniata County Board of Commissioners in cooperation with its participating municipal governments, and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the plan, and


WHEREAS, the County Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by the natural hazards that face County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County of Juniata that the Juniata County Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan as submitted this date is hereby adopted as the official mitigation plan of the County.




